Here's How Trademarks Work:

- 1. If you have a distinctive name or graphic for your company or product, you can register it as a trademark.
- You can register it for a particular territory and classification (type of goods and services).
- First, you have to conduct a search to make sure nobody else is using that name or graphic for similar goods and services.
- 4. It that is clear, you can register the trademark.
- 5. Your trademark lasts for ten years.
 Before expiration, you can renew it.
- You can exclude other companies from using your trademark.

 If they infringe your rights, you can make a legal claim.

 You should, therefore, have trademark registrations of others monitored.
